HOUSE APPROPRIATIONS COMMITTEE

THE BILL - (H.875)

H.875 - An act relating to making appropriations for the support of government: Here are the votes of House Appropriations Committee members, both in Committee and on the House floor, for passage of the 2017 budget bill. This bill increases state spending over fiscal 2016 by \$65.4 million and relies upon \$48 million in new tax and fee increases passed by the House in H.872 and H. 873. With regard to general funds, the largest source of state spending, H.875 increases spending by 4 percent or \$58.9 million and relies upon \$35 million of the \$48 million in new taxes and fees for support. Keep in mind there is another “bite of the apple” for 2017 spending next January when the 2017 Budget Adjustment will be up for legislative consideration.
